#### **FULL COUNCIL**

##### **1. Apologises for absence**

All members were present.

##### **2. Declarations of pecuniary or other interests**

There were no declarations made.

##### **3. To approve the minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> March 2025**

These were approved as a true and accurate record of the meeting.

##### **4. Matters from the previous meeting**

Cllr David Taylor confirm that the matter in the window of a property overlooking the play park was still being dealt with by Magna and the police.

Cllr's Mutti and Nutt were trying to install the new hydraulic part for the play park gate.  
A new set of instructions have been received from Online Playgrounds.

The skip for the allotments had arrived.

There was no further correspondence on a defibrillator for the Village Hall, so this matter is now closed.

##### **5. Chair's update**

The Chair had no further comments.

##### **6. Public discussion period**

It was asked if the community and Chalkstream Drivers details and timings could be placed on noticeboards.

**This was in principle agreed.**

It was asked if a bus stop sign could be erected.

**As no commercial bus goes through Frampton, it was agreed not to pursue this.**

It asked why the bus from Yeovil to Dorchester could not be diverted to pick up through Frampton.

### **7. To receive a report from the Dorset Council**

Cllr David Taylor that a new CEO had been appointed for Dorset Council.

The budget shortfall was better, being £15M rather than the original £60M.

Children's services were under immense strain both in funding and resources.

### **8. To receive brief holder updates and to agree action(s) in response to proposals and repairs Allotments**

Cllr Taylor confirmed that all rents had been paid, and two new tenants were allocated plots.

It was also agreed that the tyres must go to the dump, noting it would cost.

#### **Burial Ground**

There were no matters of concern

#### **Play Park**

Cllr Purse stated that the new equipment was still being used well and that the annual external inspection was due in May.

#### **Tibbs Hollow**

There was nothing to report.

#### **Planning**

There were no new applications.

Cllr David Taylor would chase up enforcements as to regards the stable block.

### **9. To receive and approve the financial reports and payments for authorisation**

#### **a. Payments for authorisation**

There were **7** payments (**PV's 1-7**), totalling **£ 2411.11**, that were approved and authorised for payment.

### **10. Matters from the Annual Village Meeting**

Mr Stewart Palmer of Dorchester Transport Action Group presented an idea to the meeting.

This constituted, a formal hitch-hiking proposal, where a group of registered drivers and registered passengers would collect / collected at predesignated locations within the village.

Everybody welcomed (in principle), any offers to assist with transport to the towns, but felt that this option did not cover either full safeguarding issues for the young, old, and disabled individuals and no policy for if an incident occurred on the journey.

Stewart was thanked and requested to come back in time with a fuller proposal.
