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Minutes of Full Council held on **19th May 2026** in Frampton Village Hall.
Meeting commenced at 7.00pm.

FULL COUNCIL

1. Apologies for absence

Cllr's Charlie Adler and David Nutt sent apologies.

2. Declarations of pecuniary or other interests

No declarations were made at this time.

3. To approve the minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 17th March 2026

These were approved as a true and accurate record of the meeting.

4. Matters from the previous meeting

There were no matters that were not on the agenda.

5. Chair's update

The Chair had no updates.

6. Public discussion period (agenda items)

It was requested if the Parish Council could chase up with the bridge that provides access over the right of way near Longlands. It had been reported to Dorset Council.

The Clerk requested the reference number and would escalate once received.

7. To receive a report from the Dorset Council

Cllr Taylor (DC) confirmed that the Enforcement issue had been chased. It was noted the original case officer had left Dorset Council and left a back log of over 80 open cases.

The new case officer had requested a meeting with all relevant stakeholders.

Cllr Taylor (DC) would request a date for this meeting.

It was confirmed that Dorset Council had completed their work on the draft of the Dorset Local Plan and this document would be available in September.

It was also noted that due to the large volume of Plans countrywide, this may not be adopted for 3 years.

The Clerk confirmed that he would be attending a Dorset Council planning meeting on 16th June, which will provide an update.

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Cllr Taylor (DC) also confirmed that Wessex Water were to invest £66M in Dorset water ways over the next 10 years.

8. To receive brief holder updates and to agree action(s) in response to proposals and repairs Allotments

Cllr Patsy Taylor confirmed all plots were let with the exception of the green waste disposal plot.

Burial Ground

There were no matters arising in the Burial Ground.

Play Park

Cllr Purse declared all was good in the Play Park.

Tibbs Hollow

There were no issues with Tibbs Hollow other than a note to say that one of the Rights of Way was closed.

It was suggested this was reported to Dorset Council via the portal.

Planning

There were no new planning applications.

**9. To receive and approve the financial reports and payments for authorisation
a. Payments for authorisation**

There were **8** payments (**PV's 1-8**) totalling **£ 1555.89**, that were approved and authorised for payment.

10. Matters from the Annual Village Meeting

There were no matters to take forward from the Annual Village Meeting.

11. Move to electronic business banking

Members agreed it was time to move to electronic business banking.

Unity Trust bank was suggested by the Clerk and approved by Council.

The Clerk would set the wheels in motion, with a view to close the Lloyds account and transfer to Unity Trust Bank after the deposit of the H2 precept in September.

Cllr's Antram and Taylor were authorised to be signatories.

12. Review of grass cutting contract to include disposal of grass cuttings

Members agreed to an extra £25 per cut for the collection and disposal of the grass cuttings.

13. Repairs to noticeboard at the church and future ownership

Councillors authorised the expenditure for the repairs to the noticeboard.

However, it was agreed that the noticeboard will be offered to the church as a free donation.

If not accepted by the church, no further repairs would be carried out and the noticeboard removed.

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14. Other Parish matters (not for resolution)

A lengthy briefing was given to Council on concerns regarding the site that had been proposed in the Dorset Local Plan.

This included:

Historical matters including non-fulfilment of previous Enforcement matter.

Future Certificate of Lawfulness

Lack of Enforcement action

Incorrect information about the site

Cllr David Taylor (DC) will take these matters back to the Portfolio Holder and Senior Planning Officer, with a view to facilitating an on-site meeting with local interested parties to ensure prior to making a decision on the site, all the correct information available.
